A/V VIEWING LIBRARY CATALOGUE

The Centre for Human Settlements A/V Viewing Library was established in May, 1977 at the University of British Columbia.

The elements contained within the Library and this catalogue consist of the core collection of Habitat films, ~~the video recordings of the U.N. Conference on Human Settlements and the parallel N.G.O. Habitat Forum Conference.~~ Approximately 200 new titles have been added during our first three years of operation, pertaining mostly to human settlement issues.

The Viewing Library contains the videotape transfers of the actual film programmes as far as the core Habitat Collection is concerned. This group of programmes is also available, for the most part, in the five official languages of the United Nations - English, French, Spanish, Chinese and Russian. There is also an Arabic language version available.

Although none of the material in the Viewing Library is available for "loan-out", the programmes are available from other sources.

The catalogue begins with a Subject index, followed by a Country index listing each programme and concludes with an Author/Title index. Programmes in the core Habitat Collection are identifiable by the three-letter code often an abbreviation of the country represented.
