List of speakers

The Preparatory Committee has recommended for consideration by the Conference that the list of speakers should be closed on Tuesday, 1 June 1976 at 6.00 p.m.

Registration and identification cards

Delegations that have not yet done so are requested to register as soon as possible in the Accreditation Center, 652 Burrard Street (opposite the Hyatt Regency Hotel). The registration desk will be open between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. Admission to the meeting rooms will require the production of an identification card which will be issued to delegates upon registration.

Texts of statements

These copies will be given to the interpreters and to the technical services and will assist the Secretariat in providing the best possible service. Delegations wishing to have their statements distributed in plenary to all delegations are kindly requested to provide 250 copies to be given to the Conference Officer in the plenary hall (Queen Elizabeth Theatre).

In order to facilitate the work of correspondents accredited to Habitat, delegations wishing to have their speeches distributed to the media are requested to provide 400 copies to the Media Centre in the Begg Building, 1110 West Georgia Street. The copies should be delivered prior to the delivery of the speech, and should be addressed to the Press Documents Officer whose office is located on the ground floor of the Begg Building.
