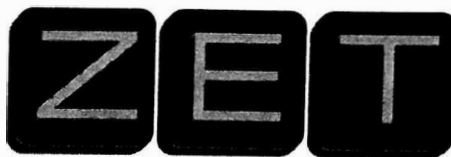
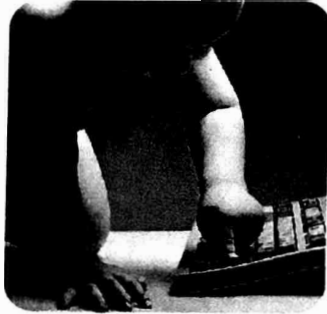

GENERAL INFORMATION

CONFERENCE VENUES

The Second United Nations Conference on Human Settlements (HABITAT II) will be held in the UN buildings located in the Conference Valley which includes **Lütfi Kırdar - İstanbul Convention & Exhibition Center, Hilton Convention Center, Cemal Reşit Rey Concert Hall, Muhsin Ertuğrul Theatre, Harbiye Cultural Center** and its Annex .

The Conference Valley is right in the heart of İstanbul (New City) and can be reached easily from most of the Conference hotels by foot.

Although some of the Parallel Activities will take place within the Conference Valley, the majority of them will be held at several other locations. These venues can be reached by shuttle buses in service or by private means.

The NGO Forum will be held at **İstanbul Technical University (İTÜ) Taşkışla Campus**. In addition, **İTÜ Maçka Campus** will also be used for some of the NGO meetings as well as their Plenary Sessions. The UN accredited NGO's will make use of the **Muhsin Ertuğrul Theatre** early in the morning and late in the evening for their daily briefings.

MEDIA CENTER

The Media Center is located at Harbiye Cultural Center Annex (Building D) which is opposite the Cemal Reşit Rey Concert Hall (Building B). All media representatives must first register at the UN Accreditation/Registration Center and receive a UN Pass in order to enter the Media Center and use the facilities.

The first floor of the building is organized for the use of the media representatives. There is a two-section Business Center. In the first section, there are telephone, facsimile and telex services (Credit cards, Smart cards, travellers cheques or cash may be used). In the second section, personal computers having internal 28.8 baud modems (allowing dial-up and electronic faxing capabilities) may be rented.

A bull pen area is available with 200 workspaces each equipped with power outlets. 50 of them have electronic typewriters with international Q-keyboards. The use of these workspaces and the typewriters is free of charge. A commercially operated heavy duty photocopy machine is also available. Daily proceedings of the Conference can be viewed from the CCTV monitors in the Media Center.

The open-air car park of the Military Museum (located just behind the Media Center) is organized for the use of broadcast needs. International TV networks will have offices here and audio/video distribution boxes will be provided for them to access the signals for their editing needs.

HEALTH CARE SERVICES & FIRST AID

In order to ensure the well being of our guests, precautionary measures have been taken by local authorities. "HABITAT II Emergency Health Care Card" will be available in the briefcases to be distributed at the United Nations Accreditation / Registration Center and the NGO Registration Center. OPENING EVENT

The Opening Event of the Conference, hosted by the President of the Republic of Turkey, will be held on Sunday, 2 June at 9:00 pm at the Open Air Theatre located in the Conference Valley.

Entitled “The Lyrical History of Istanbul”, musical rythms will reflect the historical evolution of the host city - Istanbul; a city where East meets West. North meets South, a city where Byzantine, Roman and Ottoman Empires have ruled for several centuries, preparing a rich and diverse background for the basis of the Ottoman Islamic structure.
