# I. THE CONFERENCE ITSELF

# (3 to 14 June)

abitat II, the second United Nations Conference on Human Settlements, will take place in Islanbul, Turkey from 3 to 14 June 1996. Pre-Conference consultations for participating States will be held in the Kirdar Conference Centre on I and 2 June. The opening session of the Conference will be held at 10.00 a.m. on 3 June 1996. The Conference itself will consist of a Plenary and two main Committees, and will be complemented by a series of parallel events. Committee I, dealing with the Habitat Agenda. will start on Monday afternoon, 3 June, as will Committee II, "the hearings committee", which will consider presentations from the partners' Forums and Habitat Dialogues described in Part II of this brochure.

Committee I will meet in the Hilton Convention Centre, "Ourmittee I at the C. Rey Concert Hall. The first segment of the Figures, to be held at the Istanbul Kirdar Conference Centre, from 3 to 11 June, will allow for a general exchange of views on the main themes of the Conference. The second or "high-level segment" from 12 to 14 June will provide a forum for world leaders to make commitments on actions to make cities, towns and vilages in their countries healthy, safe, just and sustainable.

## **Participation**

As decided by the General Assembly in its resolution 47/180, the Conference will be convened "at the highest possible level of participation". Government delegations have therefore been encouraged to be represented at the Conference by their Heads of State or Government who will make the specific commitments referred to above. With regard to the composition of delegations to the Conference. In addition to Ministers and government officials, the General Assembly, in its resolution 49/109, has recommended that national delegations should be broadly based, representing all the key actors, namely grassroots community leaders, civic leaders, prominent personalities, politicians at all levels of government, mayors, local authorities, nongovernmental organizations, the business community, trade unions, the academic and scientific community, youth, the media, and human settlements professionals from the public and private sectors.

National delegates will be registered after presentation of their credentials, in accordance with the Rules of Procedure of the Conference.

Lo\_al authorities: In accordance with Rule 62 of the Rules of Procedure, accredited international associations of local 24th printer will designate the representatives of local authorities at the Conference, All other representatives of local authorities will be registered for the World Asssembly of Cities and Local Authorities on the basis of lists sent to the Conference Secretariat by the G4+ Local Government Habitat II Steering Committee.

The development and collection of urban and housing indicators has been one of the major preparatory activities for Habitat II. Decisions of the first and second sessions of the Preparatory Committee and Resolution 15/6 of the Commission on Human Settlements endorsed a list of 46 key indicators as the minimal set to be collected as part of in-country preparations for Habitat II, and recommended that these and other indicators should be used as the quantitative basis for country reporting on the status of human settlements for the Conference.

Some 113 countries have participated in the Indicators Programme, of which 97 had submitted their results by 31 March 1996, including 30 Least Developed Countries. The resulting Global Urban Indicators Database, which is being improved and refined, is a unique resource for examining the problems and conditions of human settlements, and will provide baseline data for future monitoring of the Habitat Agenda and national plans of action.
